# Earth Day, Every Day!

We can keep Earth clean by following the rule of **reduce, reuse, recycle**. *Reduce* means use less. We can reduce our use of resources like water or gasoline.



*Reuse* means use again, rather than throw things away. We can reuse many things, such as jars, plastic bags, and boxes.

# Earth Day, Every Day!

*Recycle* means to make something new from something old. We can keep Earth clean by recycling materials such as aluminum, paper, and plastic.

If we take these materials to a recycling center, they can be used again in a different way.



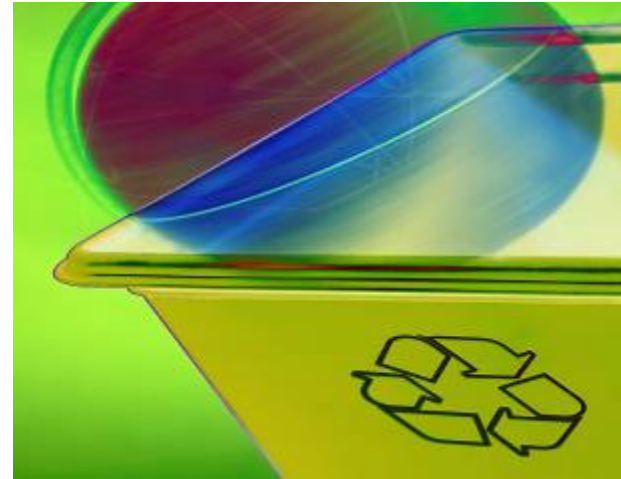
# Earth Day, Every Day!
