# About Bayley House and The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)




The National Disability Insurance Scheme:

- Is how you access and pay for the care and support you want to use
- Provides funding for individual supports and services that are reasonable and necessary
- Empowers you to choose how, when and where you get your services
- Gives choice and control
- Can pay for things like wheelchairs, support to get a job or communication support
- Support can also be to help family, carers or
   Bayley House staff look after you

You will get a plan that is just for you.

#### You should know that:




- Sharing your plan with Bayley House means
   we know how best to support you
- Your support needs may change so what you get now in your plan may change as well
- You can change service providers or access a number of different providers
- Your plan will be reviewed each year



### Who can get NDIS funding?

To get NDIS funding you must:



- Be under 65 years old
- Have a Special Category Visa

You can check online at

if you are unsure









- If you are eligible you will get funding each year
- You will be assessed to see what you need
- You then choose where to get your support

## What will the NDIS pay for?



The NDIS pays for reasonable and necessary supports that will help you achieve your goals, including:

- Regular personal care
- Accessing the community
- Becoming more independent
- Improving health and wellbeing
- Finding a job and earning an income





The NDIS may pay for:

- Transport
- Home modifications
- Mobility equipment
- Therapeutic supports

#### Your choices:



Bayley House will support you to plan and make decisions about your life:

- You will get individual support based on your needs
- We will help you create goals





## Your goals:

Using the six life areas Bayley House will help create short term and long term goals:

- Goals are made with you, your NDIS plan, your family, accommodation service, day service and anyone else important to you
- We will have a meeting each year to see how you are going with your goals
- You choose who comes to the meeting
