- Is a part-time two to three year course
- Is NDIS funded for students leaving school
- Is designed to support school leavers
- Support you to learn social skills
- Supports you to learn literacy skills
- Supports you to learn computer skills
- Supports you to learn workplace safety
- Supports you to learn travel training
- Supports you to become independent at work









- You should expect to be ready to look for a job
- You have the skills needed to apply for a job
- The confidence to apply for a job

How to join this course:



- Make sure you have SLES funding in your
 NDIS package
- Complete the application form
- Come in for an interview
- Once it is agreed you then sign a service agreement
