About Bayley HouseHome and Living



At Bayley House people with disability can:

- Get support with daily living
- Use our Short Term Accommodation



When you choose to come to Bayley House you will be provided with support that meets your needs.



What we offer in Home and Living



We currently have:

- Eight Long Term Accommodation (LTA) houses
- Two Short Term Accommodation (STA) houses
- The houses are across six Bayside suburbs
- In-Home Support Options







- SDA is an approved residential building for people who need daily in home support
- The NDIS makes SDA payments directly to the owner or landlord of the house
- When Bayley House has a vacancy we check to see who is interested in that spot
- You must have an SDA package to take the vacant spot



What is Supported Independent Living (SIL)?



- SIL is financial assistance you receive
- SIL pays for support workers who help you live as independently as possible
- Respecting your rights
- Support to make sure you are safe
- Assistance with personal care
- Social skill development
- Positive Behaviour Supports
- Support for appointments
- Help around the house like laundry and cleaning







How are SDA and SIL different?

- SDA is the house or unit where a person lives
- SIL is the staff support you receive that helps you to live as independently as possible.



How do you get SDA and SIL funds?



At your NDIS planning meeting your first goal needs to be about accommodation. You can say it like this:

- I want to live by myself/with my friends so I need SDA and SIL funding
- I want to learn how to live with other people so
 I need STA funding
- I need Support Coordination to help me apply for SDA
- I need SIL funding for my roster of care
- I need funds if a permanent spot in a house is available for me









Bayley House will send you a bill for rent, utilities food and household charges.

- You get your bill every two weeks
- These charges are not funded through the NDIS
- You can access all of your bill information in the Bayley House Billing Portal



What else is included?



- Each house has its own suitable vehicle to take you to day to day events
- Transport to and from Bayley House Day
 Service is provided
