Bayley House Home and Living Support Service is committed to increasing the number of flexible accommodation options to people who require support in daily living including long term permanent accommodation, short term respite and independent living options.



What is Home and Living Options?

In-Home Support Services

Bayley House In-Home Support Services are personalised one to one support provided within your home. We provide care, independence development, assistance with household tasks and outings into the community to ensure that you receive the care and support you need to achieve greater independence and live a full and rich life. We also provide families with the assistance and assurance that their loved ones are well supported.

Supported Disability Accommodation (SDA)

Bayley House's Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) provides you with the opportunity to live as independently as possible. SDA is an approved residential building for people who need daily in-home support. Bayley House SDA includes Improved Liveability housing with accessibility and Legacy Stock.

Supported Independent Living (SIL)

Supported Independent Living (SIL) is the personal care and support Bayley House delivers to help you live as independently as possible. We work closely with you and your family or carers to help determine your support needs and preferences then we tailor flexible, responsive, and appropriate supports that will allow you to develop your skills and independence based on your goals.

What is the difference between SIL and SDA?

SDA is the house/unit where a person lives. SIL is the staff support you receive to help you to live as independently as possible.

Long Term Accommodation

Bayley House permanent accommodation consists of eight houses across six Bayside suburbs. Bayley House provides daily living supports to 47 people. Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) and Supported Independent Living (SIL funding) is required to access this service.

Medium Term Accommodation (MTA)

Bayley House provide a personalised accommodation, care and independence development package for people who require NDIS funded MTA for up to 90 days. We offer MTA service to clients as they transition from hospital, aged care or other housing to their SDA or other suitable permanent housing or while they wait for home modifications.

Short Term Accommodation (STA)

Your home away from home where you be assisted by our trained staff to live independently, learn new skills and meet new friends. Bayley Houses provides families with an opportunity to recharge and refresh while your loved one stays in one of our purpose-built homes and enjoys new friendships and experiences. You may choose to have time there during the week, weekends or during holiday periods. We will work with you to select the best dates for your stay.

Our staff team

Bayley House experienced disability support workers have the knowledge and skills to deliver complex supports safely and appropriately. We will work with an individual's support team, hospital or current allied health team, to ensure that all client specific training has been completed.

Transport

Each house has access to a dedicated vehicle for any day-to-day events away from the residence. Transport to and from Bayley House Day Service is provided.
