You will be assisted by our trained staff to live independently, learn skills and meet new friends.

Bayley House provides families with an opportunity to recharge and refresh while your loved one stays in one of our purposebuilt homes and enjoys new friendships and experiences.

You may choose to have time there during the week, weekends or during holiday periods. We will work with you to select the best dates for your stay.

We will help you run through the Bayley House Short Term eligibility criteria and discuss your support needs to ensure that your needs are met. We will support you through the paperwork process and explain the costs and funding.

In our Short Term Accommodation homes, our qualified staff provide active support to ensure you are maximising opportunities to live a full and rewarding life.

When staying at one of our STA houses you will be supported:

- · In all aspects of your daily life
- · To participate in health and wellbeing activities
- · To attend appointments
- Develop and maintain relationships with other guests

Eligibility Criteria

To access Bayley House Short Term Accommodation, you need to:

- · Be aged 18 years and over
- Have an NDIS plan with provision for short-term accommodation, or are self-funded
- Have an Intellectual Disability and/or other Disability
- Have completed the intake process and signed a service agreement



Lonsdale Street Short Term

Located in the Bayside suburb of Hampton East our house is a single storey, wheelchair accessible residence. With close proximity to public transport and local shopping, the house is walking distance to our Hampton East campus and a nine minute drive to our Brighton Campus.

This is a home away from home with vegetable gardens, a huge TV with Netflix, computer area and commercial accredited kitchen with a stove top that responds to the simple press of the button.


